The following are revised directions coming from the north via I-75 and I-85 to help you navigate around the construction (coming from the south on I-75/I-85 should not be affected). Coming from the North (I-75):	Coming from the South (I-75/85):
Take I-75 South into the city	Take I-75/85 North through the city
To Exit 252: Northside Drive / Howell Mill. Take Northside Drive exit ramp (toward Georgia Dome)	To Exit 250 (10 <sup>th</sup> St/14 <sup>th</sup> St/Georgia Tech)
South on Northside Drive to 14 <sup>th</sup> St (0.9 mi)	Left at first light onto 10 <sup>th</sup> St (0.5 mi)
Left (east) onto 14 <sup>th</sup> to 250 14 <sup>th</sup> St (0.7 mi)	Right onto State Street (0.3 mi)
Right into 250 14 <sup>th</sup> St	Right on 14 <sup>th</sup> St (0.2 mi)
	Right into 250 14 <sup>th</sup> St
The drive is in between the 2 multistory buildings; Georgia Public Broadcasting (260 14 <sup>th</sup> St) is on the right; Conference Center is on the left (250 14 <sup>th</sup> St).	
Coming from the North (I-85):	
1. Take I-85 South into the city	5. Right onto 16 <sup>th</sup> St. (<0.1 mi)
2. To Exit 84: 17 <sup>th</sup> St (note that the southbound ramp to 14 <sup>th</sup> and 10 <sup>th</sup> Streets is closed)	6. Left onto Mecaslin St (0.2)
3. Right at first light onto 17 <sup>th</sup> St (0.3 mi)	7. Left onto 14 <sup>th</sup> St. (0.3)
4. Left at State St (0.1 mi)	8. Right into 250 14 <sup>th</sup> St.
The drive is in between the 2 multistory buildings; Georgia Public Broadcasting (260 14 <sup>th</sup> St) is on the right; Conference Center is on the left (250 14 <sup>th</sup> St).	

Once you have pulled into the drive at 250 14<sup>th</sup> Street; proceed straight ahead to the parking deck. Parking is free for the Conference Center.

The meeting will be held on the first floor, Room 119C of the 250 Building (it will be on your right as you walk out of the parking deck).
